Superintendent: Dr. Palan's report included:

- 1. Co-op Update: the buildings will be put up for sale and the students will be housed within member districts.
- 2. Title I technology update: 14 iPads and 15 Chromebooks will be ordered for Title I purposes.
- 3. The PERA committee has been working very hard on implementing the evaluation changes for the 2016-17 school year.
- 4. The district enrollment shows no change for January.

BOARD COMMITTEE REPORTS:

President: On Saturday, February 20th, a Chili Dinner will be held at the community shelter to raise funds for the park.

Building and Grounds: The meeting tonight was cancelled and will be rescheduled for a date in the near future.

Technology: The next meeting will be in March. The infrastructure is scheduled for completion in the next few weeks; discussion is on-going regarding when the 8th graders will be allowed to take the Chromebooks home; and the committee's plan is for the entire high school to adopt the 1:1 Initiative by next school year.

Kankakee Area Special Education Co-op: To reduce overhead at the Co-op it has been decided by the member districts to put the building and transportation garage up for sale. Currently, the sealed bid minimum is at \$1.6 million.

Kankakee Area Career Center: No report.

IASB-Three Rivers Division: No report.

Chamber of Commerce: There was a large turnout for the annual holiday meeting held recently.

Student Representatives: Two HS students participated in the State Chess tournament and the HS play, Spamalot, is in production.

Board Communications: Included were a thank you card from the Jr. Class, the letter sent to parents regarding the ACT, Starting Right Workshop results and the priority goals from ISBE.
